

Imminent risk (high priority):

- Patient Safety (ex: heparin drip ordering, protocol visibility)
- Revenue Impact (ex: labor & delivery charges)
- Regulatory (ex: lab label printing, order duplication)

Emerging risk:

- Charge reconciliation (ex: inaccurate charging, training)
- Ambulatory standardizations
- Hardware refresh
- Streamlining (ex: nursing handoffs, care plan, intervention)

Cumulative risks:

- Nursing handoff functionality
- Care plan optimization
- Medication administration challenges (ex: pain assessment)
